## Maths – Fractions

### Fluency (non-computer)

- Revise and recall number bonds to 10 e.g. 8+2, 7+3 etc.  
How quickly can these facts be recalled?  
Challenge: revise and recall number bonds to 20 e.g. 17+3, 18+2.

### Extension Challenge

- ‘What is bigger;  $\frac{1}{2}$  of a pizza, or  $\frac{2}{4}$  of a pizza? Draw a picture, write a sentence or ask a grown up to write a sentence to explain your answer.
