Maths

(Number , Early Learning Goal)

I can say the number that is one more and one less than a given number to 20.

Quick recall.

Ask your child to say the number that comes next. For example you say 11, they say 12.

Then ask them to do the same with the number that comes before. For example you say 11, they say 10.

Feeling clever?



Can you count in 2s? What number is 2 more and 2 less than the said number.


Maths

(Shape, space and measure, Early Learning Goal)

I can use mathematical language to talk about 3D shapes.

Look through your cupboards, in your recycling and all around the house to see what 3D shapes you can see.

Can you name these? Can you use mathematical language (faces, vertices, edges) to talk about them.



Literacy

(Reading Early Learning Goal)

I can use my sounds to independently read one of my books?

Log in to your Bug Club Account and complete 1 new book, answering the comprehension questions there.

Literacy

(Writing, Early Learning Goal)

Can I use my sounds to independently write a sentence?

Activity 1 – using the idea of the dear zoo book (being sent animals and not being able to keep them for various reasons), please write, as if you were the author, sending animals in the post and them not being able to be kept. For example, **they sent me a shark, his teeth were to sharp, so I sent him back.**

Activity 2 – choose an animal from the story and write as many adjectives as you can to describe this animal. An adjective is a word that describes/ tell someone about this animal.

REMEMBER – when writing we would like you to have a go at writing all the words. Use your sounds to help you. We are not expecting words to be spelt correctly..

Also, when writing please can you encouraged your child to write on lines.

Phonics

Please practice saying and writing all of the sounds stuck in your Reading Records. If your grown up gives you a few words with these sounds in, maybe you can use your Fred Fingers to sound them out and write them.

Other Activity Ideas

This time of year, we would be practicing for sports day. Maybe at home you could have a practice at some of these activities.

- Egg and spoon race
- Three legged race
- Running races
- An obstacle race
- A relay race
- Wheelbarrow race

Can you use differ materials from around the house to create your own safari small world area. Can you draw and cut out the animals in the story.
